CHURCH RESTORATION



Restoration work is needed to preserve our beautiful 800-year-old church for future generations

The Parish Church of St James the Great, Stonesfield has been central to the life of the village for centuries.

It is a place of welcome for all - for worship, prayer and reflection, baptisms, weddings and funerals, concerts and for visitors keen to explore our beautiful Cotswold Church.

The Church is the oldest building in Stonesfield. This year the Church celebrates its 800th anniversary – an incredible milestone – and various events are planned to mark this.



An architectural survey of the Church has recently been carried out and this has identified quite a number of restoration tasks which need to be completed.



The required work includes repairs to masonry, the Church roof and various other Church features. This restoration is necessary to ensure that the Church is maintained and preserved, both for today and for future generations of Stonesfield residents.

The total cost of the restoration work is £120,000 + VAT. An additional £24,000 in VAT will need to be paid, but hopefully this will be refunded from the Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme.

The Parochial Church Council is seeking funding from various grant-making trusts. We would also very much value the financial support of village residents.

Any contribution you are able to offer, however small, would be most gratefully received. If you feel able to contribute, details are overleaf.

It is hoped that the work will commence in summer 2023, funds permitting. It should last around 14 weeks.
